US Census (SES Child Poverty, Housing Age)

Housing built before 1950:

The percent of housing built before 1950 is a risk factor for childhood lead poisoning.

Child Poverty:

The percent of children under 5 years of age living below the federal poverty level.

Methodology:

Housing age comes from the 2000 Census long form which was sent to 16.7% of households.

Housing age is calculated from data in table H034 "Year Structure Built".

Child poverty is calculated from data in table P097 "Poverty Status in 1999 by Age".
